1. WCEA Hall of Fame

The first Hall of Fame Awards were presented at the WCEA conference held on October 12, 2000. The recipients received the award based on a passion or lifelong commitment to community education.

A. Criteria and Process:

1. The person must have a passion for community education and have been actively involved in leadership in Community Education philosophy in Wisconsin for at least 15 years. It is not necessary that the person be currently active in Community Education.
2. The WCEA Board will make selections. The Past President will assume responsibility for the awards. Recognition will take place at the annual conference.
3. Nominations submitted by WCEA members only.
4. Board will annually visit the criteria.

2. Outstanding Agency/Organization Award

- ### **A. Presented to an external (non-Community Education) agency/organization at the state or local level which has exemplified support and service in the development of Community Education for at least one year.**

3. Individual Award

- ### **A. Presented to the individual at the state or local level who has given outstanding support and/or service to the development of Community Education for a minimum of one year.**

4. Advisory Council Award

- ### **A. Presented to the Advisory Council which has exemplified outstanding achievement on a project completed within the past year.**

Awards are usually presented at the WCEA Fall Conference.
